Held: July 27, 2010

Bowling Green Township Board of trustees opened this regular meeting at 7pm with roll call. All trustees and Fiscal Officer are present.

CORRESPONDANCE

Trustee Watkins received 2 fence estimates for the fence around the playground. They also put up new back boards.

FO read into the record a resolution from the prosecutor in regards to the sale of the old truck. Trustee VanBuren made a motion to accept this resolution. Seconded by Trustee Watkins. All in favor.

ZONING INSPECTOR 2 permits

Comprehensive Plan Committee Planning commission will reconstruct comments from survey. Committee suggested list of services available posted on website. Michael reported the committee contacted ODOT to see if there are any plans for on/off ramps at 668, there are no such plans on their 5 year plan. Matt Hill from LCAT will attend the next meeting on the August 18th to discuss economic development in the area. Committee also plans to have a meeting concentrating on farmland preservation.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

FO discussed loan for new truck. Tom Decker from PNC suggested the township make monthly payments instead of one payment per year. This will save the township about \$450 a year. The payments can be directly withdrawn from the township checking account. Trustees will put a total of \$10,000 down on the truck. The total amount financed will be \$46,984.00.

NEW BUSINESS Trustee Watkins made a motion to repaint walls of community building and have Marj Bromley do the decorative painting again and cover her supply cost. Trustee VanBuren seconded the motion. All in favor.

Trustee Watkins made a motion to apply for Issue I this year, the same roads as last year. Seconded by Trustee Hupp. All in Favor. Deadline for application is Oct 1.

Trustee VanBuren made a motion to purchase 4 NO SOLICITING signs. Trustee Watkins seconded the motion. All in favor.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Dee Krier asked about the resident in Brownsville that has the tents set up for a yard sale. She asked how long they can have a yard sale. Zoning inspector said she looked into it and that it is considered a business and they have a current vendor's license.

Will Kern asked the status of changing the 5 acre. It is in the hands of the zoning commission right now and they are having difficulties getting together.


