Bowling Green Township Board of trustees opened this regular meeting at 7pm with roll call. All trustees and Fiscal Officer (FO) were present.

CORRESPONDANCE Trustee Chorpenning asked why the park committee has been removed from the agenda. FO stated she could put it back on if the board would like it to be on the agenda. He is concerned about the letter that went out on behalf of the board because it wasn't approved by the board. The letter states the township is doing a project when really the township has applied for a grant to do the project. The project has not be approved.

REPORTS

ZONING INSPECTOR Barb Selegue, zoning inspector reported she issued 2 permits for the month and she has received an application for variance from the Sorg family. She also mailed 3 junk car letters from cases discussed at junk car meeting.
