BOWLING GREEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Held August 25, 2015

Bowling Green Township Board of trustees opened this regular meeting at 7:00 with roll call. All trustees and Fiscal Officer (FO) were present.

CORRESPONDANCE FO had the proposed text amendment from the zoning commission. The trustees discussed when to hold the public hearing. Trustee Hupp made a motion to hold the public hearing on September 15th at 7pm. Trustee Chorpenning seconded the motion. Roll Call vote: Hupp yes, VanBuren yes, Chorpenning yes. FO also received and prepared a check for the townships portion of the county tire grant which is \$250

Trustee VanBuren spoke to someone offering to paint the roofs of the township buildings.

REPORTS

SAFETY New blades are needed for the mower.

ZONING INSPECTOR Zoning inspector issued 4 permits: Rodney Weller, Elizabeth Smith, Ben Hupp and Loren Stayer. She also had some information about driveway culverts.

The zoning inspector discussed the continued violation of the Wess property. Trustee Hupp made a motion to request the assistant prosecutor to proceed with the violation of the 1988 court order against Mr. and Mrs. Wess. Trustee VanBuren seconded the motion. Roll Call vote: Hupp yes, VanBuren yes, Chorpenning no.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS FO stated the board needs to choose the spring collection date for the tire grant. The fall date is October 24th, 2015. Trustee Hupp made a motion to have the spring tire collection on April 16th, 2016. Trustee Chorpenning seconded the motion. Roll Call vote: Hupp yes, VanBuren yes, Chorpenning yes.

Trustee Chorpenning said there was a motion made in April 28 2009, made by Trustees Watkins and seconded by Trustee VanBuren. The motion stated "we put in any new culverts and replace old ones. Trustee Chorpenning would like to look into the information on the culvert installation.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ron Duval asked if Trustee Chorpenning has attempted to pay back the money spent on re-installing the merry-go-round and if not why. It cost the township money to put it back in when it shouldn't have been removed. Trustee Chorpenning said Mr. Duval's information doesn't match the facts of the situation.

Barb Selegue asked if there was a vote made to remove or not to remove the merry-go-round. Trustee Hupp said there was no official vote but there was discussion to not remove the merry-go-round.

Jim Watkins asked why Trustee Chorpenning doesn't answer any questions. Trustee Chorpenning said the merry go round needed to be removed no matter what. Barb Selegue requested documents showing the merry go round needed to be removed and the cost of removal and the reinstallation.

Trustee Hupp made a motion to pay the bills; sign purchase orders and blanket certificates, and the bank statement. Trustee VanBuren seconded the motion. Motion Carried. It is lawfully certified that the amount \$9,738.46 is lawfully appropriated to pay the bills by the fiscal officer.


