**NEW BUSINESS**


Trustee Hupp said they need to start looking at purchasing a new dump truck. The spreader won't make it through another winter.


Trustees need to find out the right of way on Open Woods so they can find out if they can take some dirt off the banks in a couple areas.


**PUBLIC COMMENT**
