Received a letter from Bob Wess. This is a zoning matter and has been forwarded on to the zoning inspector.


ZONING INSPECTOR Barb Selegue turned in a report to the trustees.


NEW BUSINESS


Trustees will need to cancel the Easter Egg Hunt and close the playground.
