Correspondence: Fiscal officer received an email requesting a speed bump in Loan Oak. Trustees briefly discussed and decided it wasn't possible.

Mr. Krier on Carmel CT had questions about easement. Trustees will look into it.

Trustees discussed trash hauler bids. The 2 companies with the lowest bids were Waste Away and Adkins Disposal. After some discussion, Trustee Mack made a motion to award the single trash hauler contract to Adkins disposal. Trustee VanBuren seconded the motion. All in favor. Waste Management contract will end on August 1st and the contract with Adkins will begin August 1st.

Trustees received 1 bid for the road project, Cherry Hill, Mack and Lawyers. Small's Asphalt and Paving submitted a bid of \$261,955.59. Due to covid, the state has not released the funds for the grant. Trustee Mack made a motion to table the decision. Trustee Hupp seconded the motion. All in favor.

Culvert on Mulberry will need to be replaced. The township will rent a track hoe for a week to remove and replace culverts on the roads for the paving project.


