ZONING INSPECTOR: Barb Selegue reported some junk cars she is working on. She also had several permits.


UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Salt building- Trustee Mack will work on getting prints made up

PUBLIC COMMENT Tim May said the flag is getting pretty rough and needs replaced.


Trustee Hupp made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Trustee VanBuren. With business complete, the board adjourned at 7:39pm.


