
NEW BUSINESS: Route 40 yard sale is coming. Board decided not to get an additional porta john.

PUBLIC COMMENT:


Jack and Taylor Swinderman would like to see if the township could do something about the ditch that fills up with water in their back yard. Trustees said they would take a look at it.
