Trustee Hupp requested an update from Darcy Cook on what is going on with the Alum Creek property case. The case was before the 5th District. They did not make a ruling and sent it back to Judge Branstool. The first time Branstool looked at it he reversed the zoning amendment due to improper procedure but did not review the key points of why the appeals board denied their application. The zoning board will need to redo the zoning amendment as soon as they can. Paul Hester asked if there will be any oral arguments on this in the future. Darcy said there would not be. Trustee Hupp asked if there would be another mediation and Darcy said probably not.

Trustees discussed the roads and decided to hold the money over for next year.

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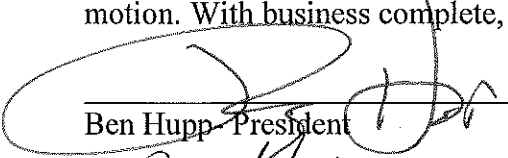
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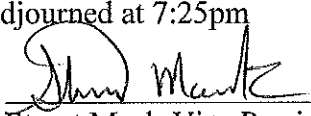
Public Comment

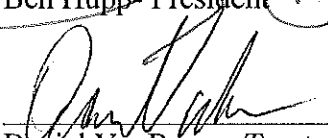

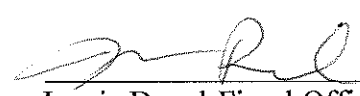
Carla Smith asked the meetings would be moved to the new building. Trustee Hupp said after the septic is installed.
