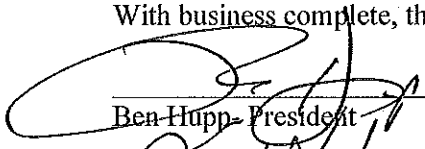

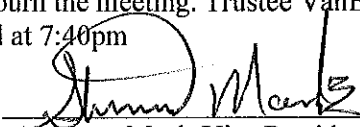

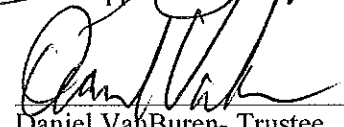
The zoning commission will hold a public hearing on September 25 at 7pm. This is the public hearing to redo the zoning amendment which was deemed invalid due to improper procedure.
